Most recently, Monique founded and launched TFA - Bay Area's

pre-service institute, setting vision and strategy for a teacher development program that annually trains over 190 early educators and touches the lives of over 1500 students. Under Monique's leadership, TFA Bay Area's training institute achieved exemplary outcomes, earning the top results across the organizations network for both corps member culture and student outcomes for large urban regions. Four years out, the Bay Area pre-service program is considered a model for other regions across the country.

Prior to her work in the Bay Area, Monique was a Managing Director, Project Management for the Executive Vice President of Teach Preparation at Teach For America. She provided data and operational support to 9 national training institutes, leading to sustained quality and growth in teacher training, efficacy, and student outcomes.

Her passion for developing others began on TFA's recruitment team, where she launched the organizations diversity recruitment efforts at the nation's historically black colleges and universities. During her time in this role, she and her teams consistently outpaced the organizations goals to recruit qualified candidates to the program.

She also holds a Masters of Urban Policy from Boston College, where she was the Donovan Urban Fellow.
